WELCOME TO THE THEATRE




Pinocchio is a theatre show that will be performed in the Concert Hall at Fairfield Halls.




East Croydon is the closest train station. There are plenty of busses that stop right out the front, and you can also park or get a taxi if needed.




When you arrive at Fairfield Halls you will see some security guards. They may want to look inside your bag.





When you get inside the theatre there will be some friendly staff to help you.




There may be lots of other people at Fairfield Halls, all waiting in the foyer for different shows to begin.

When the show is about to start, there will be an announcement and someone may want to see your ticket before you go in so you know where to sit.




Don't forget to have a copy of your ticket, which may be on paper or an email.

At the end of the show, all the actors come out onto the stage and take a bow.
